## Wi-fi Access for Visitors to Queen's

Delegates from educational institutions that are part of <a href="Eduroam"><u>Eduroam</u></a> should be able to connect securely to the Internet using the same username and password as they use at their home institution. Eduroam is available throughout the campus. **Please note:** Visitors must configure and test their Eduroam connection at their home institution before travelling. Effective support can only be provided by the home institution as authentication is relayed back and authorised by them. If the connection has not been pre-authorised, it is unlikely to be resolvable at the 'visited' location.
