Wi-fi Access for Visitors to Queen's

Delegates from educational institutions that are part of [Eduroam](#) should be able to connect securely to the Internet using the same username and password as they use at their home institution. Eduroam is available throughout the campus. **Please note:** Visitors must configure and test their Eduroam connection at their home institution *before* travelling. Effective support can only be provided by the home institution as authentication is relayed back and authorised by them.
